01 Demand

As awareness of financial literacy increases, more schools and organisations are requesting our programmes than we are currently resourced to deliver.

02 Contemporary Dangers

National trends show increasing financial vulnerability in young people — including debt, BNPL spending and exposure to gambling-style features in online games and apps. It's essential our projects adequately cover the newest dangers.

03 Rising Costs

Operational costs, travel, resources and updated material development continue to increase, and sustainable support is essential to meet growing demand.

Despite the challenges outlined above, we are **well-placed** and **confident** in our ability to continue our work — and with the support of partners, funders and stakeholders, we can **impact** even more young people and **protect** those who are most at risk.
